MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: CVMA TEXAS PROCESS FOR MEMBERSHIP APPLICATIONS (Revision 9)

- 1. The Chapter Secretary (CSEC) or Chapter Commander (CC) will submit all applications online through the CVMA National Website. (https://www.combatvet.us/) The State Representative (SR) or State Secretary (SSEC) can submit them if special circumstances arise where the CSEC and CC are unavailable.
- 2. Applications will contain:
 - a. Chapter Designation
 - b. Sponsor information for Auxiliary and Support applicants.
 - c. Former membership number for returning members.
 - d. Hand-written ink signatures and initials Only.
- 3. For applicants who were discharged from the military with "General Under Honorable Conditions", an application addendum will be required (located on CVMA National Website under Repository). A character reference letter is strongly encouraged from a member of the CEB to strengthen the application package when sent to the National Board of Directors (NBOD) for consideration.
- 4. Chapter Secretary or Chapter Commander will:
 - a. Complete online application to include residential address (no PO Box), phone number, and email address.
 - b. Upload all required documents so that they are in the upright position:
 - i. Member Application located on CVMA Website under Repository
 - ii. DD-214 must show Block 24 Character of Service and Block 26 Discharge Code
 - iii. If Active Duty current Official Military Personnel File (OMPF, NAVPERS, ERB, ORB, SURF, etc.)
 - iv. Patch Agreement located on CVMA Website under Repository
 - v. Marriage Certificate (AUX Applications)
 - vi. Other Supporting documents

- 5. Full Member (FM) Applications
 - a. Will be used for combat veterans applying for membership for the first time, or former FM who wish to rejoin CVMA.
 - i. returning FM will receive a new member number
 - b. FM Application packet will include:
 - i. Application
 - ii. DD-214 or Active Duty equivalent
 - iii. Patch Agreement
- 6. Auxiliary Member (AUX) Applications
 - a. AUX Applications will include:
 - i. Application Must indicate FM Sponsor member number
 - ii. Marriage Certificate or Marriage License
 - iii. Patch Agreement
- 7. Support Member (SUP) Applications
 - a. SUP Applications will include:
 - i. Application Must indicate FM Sponsor member number
 - ii. DD-214 or Active Duty equivalent
 - iii. Patch Agreement
- 8. Life Membership Applications
 - a. Life Membership Applications will include:
 - i. Application
 - ii. New Patch Agreement with up to date signatures and dates (do not submit the original Patch Agreement)
 - iii. Life Membership Calculator Spreadsheet (in excel format)
 - 1. Only list the three sanctioned events on this spreadsheet
- 9. Detachments
 - a. Detachment Commanders will submit applicat on packets to the CSEC or CC in which the Detachment resides.
- 10. The intent of this memorandum is to provide formal guidance, clarification, and consistency across the State for submitting membership applications.
